Preferential Procurement

Measures the extent to which enterprises procure from companies that are B-BBEE compliant.

Also encourages procurement spend on Small and Micro-enterprises and Black Owned Suppliers



Preferential Procurement requirements

B-BBEE Procurement Spend from Empowering


